London is home to some 300 theatres, 500 cinema screens and 12,000 restaurants, London's Tube is the oldest underground railway in the world. 3.5 million passenger journeys are made every day on London's 'Tube' and there were more than 1 billion journeys in total in 2010. London is Europe's largest city and the sixth richest in the world. London has four UNESCO world heritage sites: Tower of London, Maritime Greenwich, Westminster Palace, Kew's Royal Botanic Gardens. London is home to 43 universities – the largest concentration of higher education in Europe. London's One Hyde Park houses the most expensive apartment in the world at £135.4m – which make it also the fourth most expensive home – with its own SAS guard, bullet-proof glass, panic rooms and a secret tunnel to a nearby hotel. Europe's largest shopping centre – Westfield in Stratford, near the Olympic Park has 300 shops and restaurants.
